Explanatory Notes to Ordinary and Special Businesses: -

1. Audited Financial Statements for the financial year ended 30 June 2023

This Agenda item is meant for discussion only, as the provision of Section 340(1)(a) of the Companies Act 2016 does not require a formal approval from the shareholders for the Audited Financial Statements, and hence, this Agenda item is not put forward for voting.

2. Resolutions 1 to 4 - Re-election of Directors

Pursuant to Clauses 115 and 116 of the Company's Constitution, Dato' Naharudin Bin Ali, Mr. Cheong Kee Yoong, Puan Sri Fadzilah Binti Md Ariff and Dato' Nik Mohd Fuad Bin Wan Abdullah (hereinafter referred to as the "**Retiring Directors**") are standing for re-election at this 45th AGM and being eligible, have offered themselves for re-election as Directors of the Company. Each Director standing for re-election has consented to their re-election and abstained from deliberations and voting in relation to their respective re-election at the Board of Directors' Meeting.

The Nomination and Remuneration Committee ("**NRC**") had reviewed and assessed the Retiring Directors via the annual assessment. The Board of Directors, via the NRC's annual assessment, was satisfied with the performance of the Retiring Directors and has recommended to the shareholders the proposed re-elections at the 45th AGM under Resolutions 1 to 4.

The profiles of the Retiring Directors can be found in the Annual Report 2023.

3. Resolution 5 - Payment of Directors' fees

This Agenda item is to approve the Proposed Directors' fees for the financial year ended 30 June 2023 of RM410,000.00 (2022: RM250,000.00).

The Resolution 5, if approved, will authorise the payment of Directors' Fees pursuant to Clause 129 of the Company's Constitution.

4. Resolution 6 - Directors' benefits payable to Non-Executive Directors

The benefits payable to the Non-Executive Directors pursuant to Section 230(1)(b) of the Companies Act 2016 has been reviewed by the NRC and the Board of Directors of the Company, which recognises that the benefits payable is in the best interest of the Company for the applicable period of between 7 December 2023 to the next Annual General Meeting of the Company in year 2024.

The total estimated amount of Directors' benefits payable is calculated based on the number of the Board of Directors' and Board Committees' meetings scheduled to be held for the financial year ending 30 June 2024 and until the next Annual General Meeting and other benefits. This authority, unless revoked or varied by the Company in a general meeting, will expire at the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting of the Company.

5. Resolution 8 - Retention of Dato' Anuarudin bin Mohd Noor ("**Dato' Anuarudin**") as Senior Independent Non-Executive Director

The Board of Directors has vide the NRC conducted an annual performance evaluation and assessment of Dato' Anuarudin, who has served as an Independent Director for a cumulative term of more than nine (9) years, and recommended him to continue in office as the Senior Independent Non-Executive Director based on the following justifications: -

- (a) Dato' Anuarudin has met the independence guidelines as set out in Chapter 1 of the Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad Main Market Listing Requirements ("**Listing Requirements**") and is therefore able to bring independent and objective judgement to the Board;
- (b) Dato' Anuarudin has contributed sufficient time and effort in his capacity as the Senior Independent Non-Executive Director and the Chairman of the NRC and the Audit and Risk Committee ("**ARC**"). He has attended all the meetings of the ARC, NRC as well as the Board of Directors for informed and balanced decision making;
- (c) Dato' Anuarudin has exercised due care during his tenure as the Independent Director and carried out his professional duty in the interest of the Company and shareholders;
- (d) Dato' Anuarudin has not entered into any contract or transaction with the Company and/or its subsidiaries within the scope and meaning as set forth under Paragraph 5 of Practice Note 13 of the Listing Requirements;
- (e) Dato' Anuarudin has not developed, established, or maintained any significant personal or social relationship, whether direct or indirect, with the Executive Directors, major shareholders or management of the Company (including their family members) other than normal engagements and interactions on a professional level consistent with his duties and expected of himself to carry out his duties as an Independent Director; and
- (f) Dato' Anuarudin does not derive any remuneration and benefits apart from Directors' fees and meeting allowances.

The Board upon the recommendation from the NRC of the Company, therefore, considers Dato' Anuarudin to be independent and recommends him to retain as Senior Independent Non-Executive Director subject to the approval from the shareholders of the Company.

6. Resolution 9 - Authority to issue shares pursuant to the Companies Act 2016

The Company had been granted a general mandate on the authority to issue shares pursuant to the Companies Act 2016 by its shareholders at the Forty-Fourth Annual General Meeting of the Company held on 8 December 2022 ("**Previous Mandate**"). The Company wishes to renew the mandate on the authority to issue shares of not exceeding 10% of the total number of issued shares of the Company for the time being ("**General Mandate**").

As at the date of this notice, the Previous Mandate granted by shareholders has not been utilised and hence no proceeds were raised therefrom.

The purpose to seek the General Mandate is to enable the Directors of the Company to issue and allot shares at any time to such persons in their absolute discretion without convening a general meeting as it would be both time and cost-consuming to organise a general meeting solely for such issuance and allotment of shares. This authority unless revoked or varied by the Company in a general meeting, will expire at the next Annual General Meeting. The proceeds raised from the General Mandate will provide flexibility to the Company for any possible fund-raising activities, including but not limited to further placing of shares, for the purpose of funding future investment project(s), working capital and/or acquisition(s).

Pursuant to Section 85 of the Companies Act 2016 read together with Clause 14 of the Constitution of the Company, shareholders have pre-emptive rights

to be offered any new shares in the Company which rank equally to the existing issued shares in the Company or other securities.

The Resolution 9, if passed, would allow the Directors to issue new shares to any person under the authority to issue shares pursuant to the Companies Act 2016 without having to offer the new shares to be issued equally to all existing shareholders of the Company prior to issuance.

Notes:-

1. The 45th AGM will be conducted on a virtual basis by way of live streaming and online remote voting via the Remote Participation and Voting ("**RPV**") facilities to be provided by SS E Solutions Sdn. Bhd. via Securities Services e-Portal's platform at <https://sshsb.net.my/>. Please read carefully and follow the procedures provided in the Administrative Guide to register, participate and vote remotely via the RPV facilities.
2. The Broadcast Venue, which is the main venue of the 45th AGM, is strictly for the purpose of complying with Section 327(2) of the Companies Act 2016 and Clause 77 of the Company's Constitution, which require the Chairman to be present at the main venue of the 45th AGM. Members, proxies and/or corporate representatives will not be allowed to be physically present at the Broadcast Venue on the day of the 45th AGM.
3. With the RPV facilities, the members, proxies and/or corporate representatives are strongly encouraged to exercise their rights to participate (including to pose questions to the Chairman, Board of Directors, or Management) and vote at the 45th AGM.

As guided by the Securities Commission Malaysia's Guidance Note and Frequently Asked Questions on the Conduct of General Meetings for Listed Issuers, the right to speak is not limited to verbal communication only but includes other modes of expression. Therefore, all members, proxies and/or corporate representatives shall communicate with the main venue of the 45th AGM via real time submission of typed texts through a text box within Securities Services e-Portal's platform during the live streaming of the 45th AGM as the primary mode of communication. In the event of any technical glitch in this primary mode of communication, members, proxies and/or corporate representatives may email their questions to eservices@sshsb.com.my during the 45th AGM. The questions and/or remarks submitted by the members, proxies and/or corporate representatives will be responded by the Chairman, Board of Directors and/or Management during the 45th AGM if time permits or by email after the 45th AGM.

4. In respect of deposited securities, only members whose names appear in the Record of Depositors on 30 November 2023 ("**General Meeting Record of Depositors**") shall be eligible to attend the Meeting.
5. A member entitled to attend and vote at the 45th AGM, shall be entitled to appoint more than one (1) proxy to attend, participate, speak, and vote instead of the member at the 45th AGM. A proxy needs not be a Member of the Company. There shall be no restriction as to the qualification of the proxy. A proxy appointed to attend and vote at the 45th AGM shall have the same rights as the Member to attend, participate, speak, and vote at the 45th AGM and upon appointment a proxy shall be deemed to confer authority to demand or join in demanding a poll.
6. Where a member appoints more than one (1) proxy, he shall specify the proportion of his shareholdings to be represented by each proxy, failing which the appointment shall be invalid.

7. Where a member of the Company is an exempt authorised nominee which holds shares in the Company for multiple beneficial owners in one (1) securities account (“**omnibus account**”), there is no limit to the number of proxies which the exempt authorised nominee may appoint in respect of each omnibus account it holds.
8. The instrument appointing a proxy shall be in writing under the hand of the appointor or of his attorney duly authorised in writing or, if the appointor is a corporation, either under its seal or under the hand of an officer or attorney duly authorised.
9. The instrument appointing a proxy must be deposited at Securities Services (Holdings) Sdn. Bhd., Level 7, Menara Milenium, Jalan Damanlela, Pusat Bandar Damansara, Damansara Heights, 50490 Kuala Lumpur, Wilayah Persekutuan **not less than forty-eight (48) hours** before the time for holding the 45th AGM or at any adjournment thereof or submit electronically via Securities Services e-Portal at <https://sshsb.net.my/> before the proxy form submission cut-off time as mentioned above. For further information on the electronic submission of proxy form, kindly refer to the Administrative Guide.
10. Any Notice of Termination of Authority to act as Proxy must be received by the Company before the commencement of the 45th AGM or at any adjournment thereof, failing which, the termination of the authority of a person to act as proxy will not affect the following in accordance with Section 338 of the Companies Act 2016: -
 - (a) the constitution of the quorum at such meeting;
 - (b) the validity of anything he did as chairman of such meeting;
 - (c) the validity of a poll demanded by him at such meeting; or
 - (d) the validity of the vote exercised by him at such meeting.
